Giving Bikers & Motorcycle Enthusiasts the Send-off They Deserve



About this service and why I only require a set donation to charity for its use

My custom-built three-wheeled motorcycle is powered by a Ford Scorpio 2.9 litre fuel injected V6 engine and draws a specially made open-top bier, on which the loved one's coffin rests, giving an unhindered view of it from all sides during the funeral procession and after. Do not worry if it is raining; a microfiber towel is carried to dry the coffin, which takes less than one minute. All in black, twenty-five feet in length, and with a pair of straight-through three-into-one exhausts that makes heads turn, my aim is to give the ultimate last ride for a biker or motorcycle enthusiast.

In 2016 I created this service to help bereaved families who want to give their loved one the send-off they deserve, by way of a motorcycle themed funeral, but found the cost of hiring a business to carry it out an expensive additional cost. I not only ask for one third of the price that a business would charge, but all the money goes to charity.

Having been a biker for 57 years, I know the meaning of brotherhood, and your loved one will be in capable hands. It is an honour and a privilege for me to convey a biker on their last ride, and for that reason I could not accept payment in return for providing this service.
