

Traditional Black Daimler Hearse



About this service and why I only require a set donation to charity for its use

I can provide a traditional black hearse together with an experienced driver in formal funeral attire, together with a cap if required, in South Devon.

The hearse is a black Daimler XJ 4.0 Super V8 coach-built in the UK by Wilcox, who are the only authorised Daimler/Jaguar coachbuilders worldwide, and they were chosen to build the State Hearse in which Her Majesty the Late Queen Elizabeth II was conveyed. In fact, it is the exact make & model used for the funeral of the Late Queen Elizabeth, the Queen Mother, in 2002. It has full-length non-tinted windows on each side of where the coffin rests so that it can be seen clearly in its entirety, and on dark days roof lights illuminate the area. The coffin rests on a rich walnut-finished deck with cover boards fitted so that the maximum amount of floral and other tributes can be placed around the coffin.

The hearse has a private registration number ending in HRH and does not have any business signage. It has a satellite navigation system together with a hands-free mobile phone facility with automatic answering, which allows other persons in the cortege to speak to the hearse's driver safely. Air conditioning, leather seats, and burr walnut veneers add to the hearse's luxurious interior. These same facilities, together with those mentioned in the previous paragraph, also apply to my white Daimler XJ hearse.

Like my alternative hearse services, I do not require any payment for myself for providing this service.
